

relating a surplus for paving Third Street.

An Ordinance, declaring a surplus on account of street paving by the "Warren Construction Company," on Third street, from the East curb line of Calapooia street to the West curb line of Baker street, excepting therefrom the intersections of Washington, Ferry, Broadalbin, Ellsworth and Lyon streets with said Third street, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany, to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of Third street, heretofore assessed and entered upon the books of City Liens of the City of Albany, Oregon, for making such improvement, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows

Section 1. That a surplus of eight and 71 hundredths per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and the "Warren Construction Company," for the improvement of Third street, from the East curb line of Calapooia street, and the West curb line of Baker street, excepting therefrom the intersections of Washington, Ferry, Broadalbin, Ellsworth and Lyon streets with said Third street, and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said Third street, and heretofore assessed for making such improvement, to their several interests may appear.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby directed to enter in the books of City Liens, in the surplus column thereof, a credit of eight and 71 hundredths per cent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered thereon, to defray the cost of the improvement of said portion of said Third street; said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such various parcels of real estate, in sums as follows, to wit: -
