

## ORDINANCE NO. 374

Ord 374

Whereas, by Ordinance No. 370 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 13th day of March, 1912, and approved by the Mayor on the 14th day of March, 1912, it was ordered that the following street in said City of Albany, to-wit: Seventh Street from the east curb line of Calapooia Street to the west curb line of Railroad Street, except the intersections with Lyon, Franklin, Broadalbin, Ferry and Washington Streets, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Whereas, by Ordinance No. 370 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 13th day of March, 1912, and approved by the Mayor on the 14th day of March, 1912, it was ordered that the following street in said City of Albany, to-wit: Seventh Street from the east curb line of Calapooia Street to the west curb line of Railroad Street, except the intersections with Lyon, Franklin, Broadalbin, Ferry and Washington Streets, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.

Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with asphaltic bituminous pavement.

Third: By laying and constructing asphaltic bituminous paving.

Fourth: By constructing catch basins.

Fifth: By construction sidewalk.

Sixth: By laying asphaltic sewer pipe.

Seventh: By laying a rock curb and steps.

All improvements to be made in accordance with the first and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the City Recorder or Clerk of Albany, Oregon.

Whereas, it was provided in said ordinance that the cost of said improvements to be laid in the roadway, said improvement to the magnitude of one-half of one cent per cubic yard,

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement published and given to the Mayor of said City according to law and Ordinance just before and to-wit on the 27th day of March, 1912, the Laraine Construction Company, corporation of Portland, Oregon, presented to the Council of said City, it is so making

said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid will be carried out to the best of the Company's power to furnish all material and implements, and to have the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices.

Excavation, per cubic yard,	\$ 0.75
Fence, per cubic yard,	\$ 0.20
Brick Bituminous asphalt, per square yard,	\$ 1.55
Gravel Bituminous asphalt, per cubic foot,	\$ 0.37
Catch basins, each,	\$ 20.00
Drivets, each,	\$ 8.10
Six-inch vitrified sewer pipe, per linear foot,	\$ 0.55

And Whereas, said Warren Construction Company was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best therefore.

Section 1. That the said bid of the Warren Construction Company is said in the event of said described street to be accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of the City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Warren Construction Company, for the making of said improvement as aforesaid, on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the addendum thereto annexed.

Said contract to provide further, that the work of said improvement shall commence within twenty days after the signing of said contract, and to proceed until completion that all the work embraced in said contract, shall be entirely completed or before the 1st day of June, 1912, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be liable to suffer damages to the sum of \$25,000, if they for any cause delay the work so delayed to more than six months time; and that the said Warren Construction Company will furnish a bond in the sum of \$25,000.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, for the security of the City of Albany in the performance of the contract, in the part of the said Warren Construction Company, and for the payment of the amount of the City of Albany against the same, and the sum for labor, materials and otherwise for the carrying out of the said contract.
