

Ord 578

and ordinance providing for the time and manner of improvement for the street from the East line of Administration Street to the west curb line of Main Street, and for the same purpose to raise a fund, the several ordinances of the City of Albany by the assent of persons qualified to receive the same, and to be completed within the time a road for, and the raising of a fund and sufficient amount to give the improvement of the said street a permanent and substantial character, and for the purpose of the same to the records of said City of Albany, and for the completion of the improvement of said street.

The People of the City of Albany do hereby enact as follows:

Section 1. That from the East line of Administration Street to the West curb line of Main Street, except the intersections with Lyon, Ellsworth, Broadwater and Ferry Streets, and to be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: To paving said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: To paving the roadway of said street from width with full intersections with grace bitu lithic pavement.
- Third: To raising an construction gravel bitu lithic bedders
- Fourth: To constructing stone basins
- Fifth: To constructing inlets
- Sixth: To raising vitrified sewer in

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the laws and ordinances of the City of Albany, and as the same may be specified and estimated in the City Engineer of said City, and the improvement of said Street to be made in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Albany on the 15th day of February, 1892, and to be made in accordance with the plans and specifications for the improvement of said Street to cross the east line of Administration Street to the west curb line of Main Street, and the estimate of the cost to be done on said street to be the probable cost thereof.

The cost of such improvement of said portion of said Street at the cross corners and elsewhere thereof to be paid by the City of Albany out of the financial funds of said City, there maintaining a portion of the cost of said improvement of said Street to be paid out of the funds of said City and a sinking fund out of the improvement of said street, and declared by Ordinance No. 576 passed by the Council of said City of Albany, on the 15th day of April, 1892, and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 22nd day of April, 1892.
