

ORDINANCE NO. 571

Ord 579

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a Contract with the Warren Construction Co., of said City of Albany, Oregon, to construct a sewer line from the East line of Washington Street to the West line of Main Street.

The People of the City of Albany do claim as follows:

Whereas, by Ordinance No. 570 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 12th day of April, 1912, it was ordered that the following street in said City of Albany, to-wit: Fourth Street, from the East line of Washington Street to the West end line of Main Street, to be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street, full width with granite intersections with granite vitrified brick pavements.
- Third: By laying and constructing granite bitu lithic basals.
- Fourth: By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth: By constructing inlets.
- Sixth: By laying a tiled sewer pipe.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer there on file with the City Recorder of said City of Albany, and,

Whereas, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of said City give notice, or bids for the making of said improvements in the manner provided in and by said Ordinance, and,

Whereafter due notice and advertisement were made and given by the City Recorder of said City, according to law and the Ordinance aforesaid, to-wit: On the 11th day of May, 1912, the Warren Construction Co., a corporation, of Portland Oregon, presented to the Council of said City its bid for making and improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by and by which said Warren Construction Company proposed to furnish all material and implements, and perform the labor necessary to make the labor described in paragraph 1st of the following proposed prices:

- Excavation, per cubic yard, \$1.00
- Fill, per cubic yard, \$2.00
- Gravel Bitumithic material, per cubic yard, \$6.50
- Gravel Bitumithic material, per cubic yard, \$4.00
- Catch Basins, per set, \$10.00

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Dallas, each \$15.00 Style Co.

and the lowest bidder was the Warren Construction Company and the bid was the lowest

Resolved that the said bid of the Warren Construction Company for said improvement of said described streets be and the same is hereby accepted, and the said Warren Construction Company are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Warren Construction Company for the making of said improvement as aforesaid, on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the agreement, revised as herein mentioned.

Said contract to provide further, that the work of said improvement shall commence within thirty days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted with the same vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be completed on or before the 1st day of August, 1912, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$5.00 per day for every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the Warren Construction Company, as a condition in the sum of \$5,000.00 to be furnished by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, as a surety and surety Company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract, on the part of the Warren Construction Company, or its assigns, indemnifying the City of Albany against any claims or losses by labor or materials or the part of any person arising out of said contract.
