

ORDINANCE NO. 580.

Ord 580

(a) To begin at the northeast corner of the City of Galloway and run a line due East to the intersection of Main Street and Point Road.

From the intersection of Main Street and Point Road run a line due North to the intersection of Main Street and Mineral Street, and

from the intersection of Mineral Street and Main Street run a line due West to the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street, and

from the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street run a line due South to the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street, and

from the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street run a line due East to the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street, and

from the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street run a line due South to the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street, and

from the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street run a line due East to the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street, and

(b) A line running due North from the intersection of Mineral Street and Mineral Street to the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street which is 71 feet long.

(c) A line running due North from the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street to the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street which is 384 feet long.

(d) A line running due North from the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street to the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street which is 209 feet long.

(e) A line running due North from the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street to the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street which is 209 feet long.

(f) A line running due North from the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street to the intersection of Water Street and Mineral Street which is 209 feet long.

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meet above said city base of grade.

(2) At a point on the center line of Water Street which is 347 feet west from the front door of the post office at a distance of 35 feet above said city base of grade.

Section 2. This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and health, and the welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany, State of Oregon, at the point where the river Willamette meets the Willamette River, the river being the same as the river Willamette, and compare the one mile to the lower end of the river and the city of the City of Albany, and cities in emergency, to prevent the spread of disease, and the immediate preservation of the public peace and health of the citizens and a public health hazard will be submitted.
