

Ord. 585

An Ordinance, authorizing the mayor and city recorder of the City of Albany, to convey to the Oregon Electric Railway Company, a corporation, a right of way for railway purposes over a parcel of land belonging to said city, situated in section five (5), township eleven (11) south of range three (3) west of the Willamette Meridian.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Recorder be and they are hereby authorized and authorized on behalf of the city of Albany to convey to the Oregon Electric Railway Company a right of way over, across and upon a parcel of land belonging to the city of Albany, located in section five (5), township eleven (11) south of range three (3) west of the Willamette Meridian in Clatsop County, Oregon more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north boundary line of Anderson Goddard's land claim number 49, distant 518 feet easterly measured across said north boundary line from the northwest corner of said donation land claim number 49; thence south 17° 51' west a distance of 177.0 feet, more or less, to the center line of a creek; thence northwesterly following the center line of said creek a distance of 200 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the said north boundary line of the donation land claim number 49; thence north 48° 45' east following along said north boundary line of donation land claim number 49 a distance of 351 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning. The area contained in the parcel of land hereinabove described being 6180 acres, more or less.

Section 2. The assessment authorized by this ordinance to be conveyed by this ordinance shall be for the purpose of permitting the railway company to enter upon said right of way and construct and maintain thereon certain railway tracks, in the use of said railway company, its successors and assigns, which assessment shall terminate at the expiration of two years from the date of the approval of this ordinance.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the immediate construction of said railway tracks are for the security, health, peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the city of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance

shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the council, and approval by the mayor of said city.
