

ORDINANCE NO. 591

Ord 591

An Ordinance Entitling The Mayor and Recorder,
The City of Albany, Oregon, to Enter into a Contract With the Warren
Construction Company for the Improvement of First Street, From the
West Curb Line of Montgomery Street to the East Curb Line of Main
Street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Whereas, By Ordinance No. 581 of the City of Albany, Oregon,
passed by the Council on the 2^d day of May, 1912, it was ordered
that the following street in said City of Albany, to-wit: First
Street, from the west curb line of Main Street to the east curb
line of Main Street, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.

Second: Re-laying the roadway of said street with
full intersections with a new bituminous pavement.

Third: Providing and constructing a new bituminous
curb.

Fourth: Constructing gutters.

Fifth: Construction ditches.

Sixth: Laying in new sewer pipe.

Paid improvement above to be made in accordance with the char-
ter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and
specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with
the City Recorder of said City, to-wit, and,

Whereas, it was voted in said Ordinance that the
Council of said City give notice or bills on the making of said im-
provement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance;
and,

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement therein
made and given to the City Recorder, said City, according to law
and by ordinance above named, to-wit, on the 10th day of April, 1912, the Warren Construction Company, a corporation, of Se-
attle, Oregon, proposed to the Council of said City, its bill for
making said improvement, which bill was made in due form,
and in accordance with all the requirements imposed by law and
the Council, by which and by said Warren Construction Company
agreed to furnish all material and implements, and labor at the
labor necessary to make the work required for the perform-
ing named work;

Granted, with the present, including the execution

And Whereas, said Warren Construction Company was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best thereof.

Action. That the said bid of the Warren Construction Company for said improvement, and described street, and the same is hereby accepted, as, the Mayor and City of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Warren Construction Company, for the making of said improvement as aforesaid, on behalf of the City of Albany, Circus, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the agreement hereinabove mentioned.

and contract to provide, further, that the work of said improvement shall commence within 60 days after the signing of said contract, and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed or worked before the 1st day of January, A.D. 1882, or the City of Albany, Circus, shall be deemed to suffer damage to the extent of \$2500 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said time; and that the Warren Construction Company, for its services, will receive of \$5,000.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City, to be deposited by him as security against the payment of all expenses incidental to the carrying on of the business in the State of New York. - Signed for the city for the purpose of said contract, on the part of the Warren Construction Company, and further identifying the City of Albany, Circus, and giving ordinances for labor, work and materials to the part of any person arising out of such contract.
