

ORDINANCE NO. 591

Ord 591

An Ordinance authorizing The Mayor and Recorder of The City of Albany, Oregon, to Enter into a Contract With the Warren Construction Company in the improvement of First Street, from the West Curb Line of Montgomery Street to the West Curb Line of Main Street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows

Whereas, By Ordinance No. 581 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 22nd Day of May, 1912, it was ordered that the following street in said City of Albany, to wit: First Street, from the West Curb Line of Montgomery Street to the West Curb Line of Main Street, be improved in the following manner, to wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street with asphalt with full intersections with concrete bitumastic pavement.
- Third: By raising and constructing a concrete sidewalk.
- Fourth: By constructing gutters.
- Fifth: By constructing inlets.
- Sixth: By raising and installing sewer pipe.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the City Recorder of said City of Albany, and,

Whereas, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Council of said City give notice as to the raising of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance, and,

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement as herein made and given to the City Recorder of said City, according to law and the ordinance aforesaid, to wit: as to the raising of said improvement, the Warren Construction Company, a corporation of said State of Oregon, was called to the Council of said City, its bid, or maximum bid in amount, which bid was made in due form, and in compliance with the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said said Warren Construction Company proposed to furnish all material and labor, and to perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the sum of \$10,000.00.

That said City be and it is the duty of said City to pay the sum of \$10,000.00 to the Warren Construction Company, including the purchase of material

And Whereas, said Warren Construction Company was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best thereof.

Section 1. That the said bid of the Warren Construction Company for said improvement of said described street is and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Warren Construction Company, for the making of said improvement as aforesaid, on behalf of the City of Chicago, Illinois, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the agreement, conditions and specifications mentioned

said contract to provide further, that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten (10) days after the signing of said contract, and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of November, 1912, and the City of Chicago, Illinois, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$20.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time; and that the Warren Construction Company shall be liable in the sum of \$5,000.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Chicago, Illinois, as surety for the performance of said contract, on the part of the Warren Construction Company, and further, that the City of Chicago, Illinois, shall be deemed to suffer damages for labor, work and material on the part of any person receiving work of said contract.
