* Third, By laying and construct[ing] gully pits in the line of

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Sixth Street from the east line of Washington Street to the west curb line of Baker Street, providing that the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damages to the City of Albany by the person or persons making said improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time herein set on, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, with a list of said streets, and providing for the notice by the recorder of said City of proper notice or bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said streets.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Sixth Street from the east line of Washington Street to the west curb line of Baker Street, except the intersections with Ferry, Lewis, Adams, Elm, Washington and Lyon Streets, in said City, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper grade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with gravel bitulithic pavement.
- Third: By constructing catch basins.
- Fourth: By constructing inlets.
- Fifth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the plans and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City, for the improvement of said Sixth Street, filed in the office of the City Recorder of said City of Albany, on the 12th day of June, 1910, endorsed: "City Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of Sixth Street from the east line of Washington Street to the west curb line of Baker Street, and the estimate of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereon."

The cost of said improvement of said Sixth Street at the crossings or intersections thereof with other streets shall be paid by the City of Albany out of the General Fund of said City; the remaining portion of the cost of said improvement of said Sixth Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessment hereon made, as contained and set out in Ordinance No. 574 passed by the Council of said City of Albany, on the 5 day of June, 1910, in the 5th and part of 6th adjacent to said portion of said Sixth Street, to be improved, and a copy of said ordinance

beneficial thereby, as provided by the charter of said city.
 The improvement of said Sixth Street shall be completed by
 the 1st day of November, 1912.
 All bids for the making of said improvement or which are
 deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany, may be
 rejected.

Any firm, corporation or person with which or with whom
 any contract is made entered into by said city or the making of said
 improvement, shall before commencing said improvement, and at
 the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to
 said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient
 security in the sum of \$5,000.00 for the faithful performance of such
 contract.

Section 2. If the firm, corporation or person entering into
 any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement
 of said Sixth Street shall not complete the same within the time men-
 tioned and specified in such contract, said city shall be deemed
 to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$25.00 per
 day, for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed be-
 yond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be
 paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof,
 unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by
 the Council.

All payments made in full in law and suitable manner
 and not otherwise.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby authorized
 and directed to immediately give proper notice or bids on the
 making of said improvement of said portion of said Sixth Street,
 by advertising same in the Albany Evening
 Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany,
 for a period of ten days, the time and amount being the cost
 of said improvement, said Sixth Street.
