

## ORDINANCE NO. 598.

Ord 598

This ordinance to ascertain, determine and charge  
the probable cost of certain improvements to a street in the City of  
the City of Albany, Oregon, was determined in Resolution No. 16,  
adopted by said Council on January 13, 1912, to make no Third Street  
in said City from the West curb line of Baker Street to the West curb line  
of Railroad Street; to ascertain, as in, dimensions and declare the  
proportionate share or responsibility cost of such improvement  
of said Third Street that is caused or created by property in  
adjacent to said said Third Street to be so improved; to have  
the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment  
in the Docket of City Dens, as provided by the charter of said City.

Whereas, on the 12th day of April, 1912, the Council of the  
City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the  
City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for  
the improvement of Third Street from the West curb line of Baker  
Street to the West curb line of Railroad Street in said City with  
concrete pavement, and for the installing of a gas distribution  
system, and for the estimates of the work to be done on the west portion  
of said Third Street, and the probable cost thereof, and requiring  
that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be  
filed in the City Recorder's office of said City on or before the 24th day  
of April, 1912, and resolution being endorsed "Resolution No.  
16" and adopted April 13th, 1912; and

Whereas, the City engineer of said City of Albany pursuant  
to said resolution has made plans, specifications and estimates  
as directed by said resolution for the improvement of said Third  
Street in the manner and subject to said resolution No. 16 and  
filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office  
of said City of Albany on the 22nd day of March, 1912, endorsed,  
"City Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement  
of Third Street across the West curb line of Baker Street to the West  
curb line of Railroad Street and the estimate of the work to be  
done on said street and the probable cost thereof; and

Whereas, the City Council on the 12th day of June,  
1912, by resolution No. 18, duly adopted by said council determined and  
resolved that it be and it is hereby ordered that said council pay  
to improve said street from the West curb line of Baker Street to the  
West curb line of Railroad Street in the manner provided in said resolution  
No. 16, and

Whereas, in and by said resolution No. 18, adopted as aforesaid  
by the council, the City Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed  
by said council to his office on and about the 1st day of July, 1912,  
to improve said street from the West curb line of Baker Street to the

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curb line of Railroad Street as is ordered by the charter of said City of Albany, and

Whereas, the City Recorder, in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council, of the said City of Albany, did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Third Street in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and

Whereas, the said Council in and by said resolution No. 18 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement and said cost to be divided in the proportion of one-half to said third street portion of said Third Street to improve as aforesaid in said resolution No. 18 to be the sum of \$3,700.22 and the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Third Street to be the sum of \$49,89.48;

Therefore,

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Third Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West curb line of Main Street to the East curb line of Railroad Street shall be improved as follows:

First. By grading said street to the proposed grade.

Second. By paving the roadway of said street, of the width, width, and intersections, with concrete pavements.

Third. By raising a. or constructing concrete borders.

Fourth. By constructing iron.

Fifth. By laying a flagstone sewer, if any.

All in accordance with said resolution No. 18 and the time and specifications for said improvement filed with the City Engineer with the City Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 2nd day of May, 1912.

Section 2. That the probable cost of said proposed improvement of said third street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West curb line of Main Street to the East curb line of Railroad Street in the manner as to be determined by the Council of said City of Albany, in and by said resolution No. 18 is to be divided to be the sum of \$49,89.48.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said third street as aforesaid is to be paid therefrom, subject to said part of said street being used as a public walk, determined by said Council in and by

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and resolution No. 18 is hereby maintained and declared to be  
the same, and for the immediate, after the separate description  
of each grantee lot or part thereof, as follows:
