

ORDINANCE NO. 601.

Ord 601

An ordinance requiring all railroad companies and all street car companies within the City of Albany, Oregon, to place, install and maintain certain electric lights, to within the City of Albany, and providing a penalty for violation hereof.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That all railroad companies and all street car companies having a railroad track or street car track within the City of Albany are hereby required to place, install and maintain electric lights along the line of such railroad or street car line at each crossing of a street to said railroad or street car line, said lights to be arc electric lights of 2000 candle (nominal) power and to keep the same lighted during all hours of darkness.

Section 2. That unless each railroad company or street car company having a line of track within the City of Albany, Oregon, shall comply with the provisions of this ordinance within four months from the passage hereof, it shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, shall be punished by a fine not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00 and each day's failure to provide the lights as required by Section 1 of this ordinance shall be a separate offense.
