

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Second Street from the east curb line of Main Street to the west curb line of Harrison Street, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for the completion of such improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows

Section 1. That Second Street from the east curb line of Main Street to the west curb line of Harrison Street shall be improved in the following manner:

- First. By grading said street to the required sub-grade.
- Second. By grading said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, two feet wide.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charters and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City for the improvement of said Second Street filed in the office of the City Recorder of said City on the 14th day of June, 1912.

The cost of said improvement of said portion of Second Street at the crossings or intersections thereof by other streets shall be paid by the City of Albany out of the general fund of said City, the remaining portion of the cost of said improvement of said Second Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising from and out of the assessment heretofore made, ascertained and determined by ordinance No. 606 passed the council of the said City of Albany on the 19th day of August, 1912 and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 19th day of August, 1912, and the lots and parts thereof adjacent to said portion of said Second Street to be improved and assessed and partitioned as required thereby as provided by the charter of said City.

The improvement of said Second Street shall be completed by the first day of October, 1912.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation who enters into any contract made on behalf of the City in making of said

improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to the city a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Second Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in the said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in said contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give notice for bids for the making of said improvements of said portion of Second Street, by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of letting the work of said improvement of said Second Street.
