

ORDINANCE NO. 611.

Ordinance
No. 611

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon to enter into a contract with C. W. Stocksteader for the improvement of Price Street from the south line of Front Street to the North curb line of Salem Road.

Whereas by Ordinance No. 609 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed on the 2nd day of May, 1912, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, to-wit, Price Street, from the south line of Front Street to the north curb line of Salem Road, be improved in the following manner:

First. By grading said street to the required grade.
Second. By graveling said street six inches deep in the center and sixteen inches deep at the outer edges, 15 feet wide.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the City Recorder of the City of Albany; and,

Whereas, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany, give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance, and,

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids was given by the City Recorder of said City, according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: On the 1st day of September, 1912, C. W. Stocksteader presented to the council of said city his bid for making said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the council, by which said bid said C. W. Stocksteader proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the sum of \$652.00.

And Whereas, said C. W. Stocksteader was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best offer;

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the said bid of the said C. W. Stocksteader for said improvement of said described street be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said city are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said C. W. Stocksteader, for the making of said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the

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agreement hereinabove mentioned.

Baid contract to provide further that work of said improvement shall commence within thirty days after the signing of said contract and to prosecute with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed no or before the First day of November, 1912, and the City of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time; and that said C. W. Dinksteader furnish labor in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said C. W. Dinksteader and further indemnify the City of Albany against any claim or liens, or labor, work or materials at the parts of any persons arising out of such contract.
