Ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract with Barrett Brothers to purchase a combination chemical and hose wagon and attachments.

Whereas the City of Albany is greatly in need of additional fire apparatus, and

Whereas Barrett Brothers have submitted to the council a proposition to furnish to the City of Albany, a Combination Chemical and Hose Wagon, according to the following specifications, to-wit:

Specifications.

Combination Chemical and Hose Wagon F. D.

- Chassis "White" 4. T. 13.
- Engine Forty horsepower (40 H.P.)
- Tires Moto Cushion, 12.5 in. mountable.
- Starter "White" electric self starter.
- Plating All bright parts to be nickel plated.
- Color Painting to be painted Fire Dept. Red with plenty gold leaf trim.
- Lettering On sides of body "Albany F. D."
- " " " " "Hood "A. F. D."
- Chemical Tanks Two (2) of heavy copper forty (40) gallon capacity with suitable piping, valves and gauges, and so arranged that tanks can be discharged singly and either one filled while the other is discharging. Filling pipe to be arranged with 2 1/2" inlet connection.
- Chemical Equipment two (2) soda canisters, four (4) acid receptacles.
- Four (4) suitable carriers for extra acid and soda canisters to be placed on foot board.
- Chemical Hose Reel Having capacity for three hundred (300) feet one inch hose, and equipped with two thru wheel and fifty ft. one inch chemical hose.
- Chemical Nozzle One (1) with two (2) tips 3/8" and 1/2 inch.
- Hand Fire Extinguishers Two (2) three gallon fire dept. standard similar mounted on foot board.
- Hose Bed Carrying capacity 1500 feet of 2 1/2 inch hose. There is to be nickel plated hand reel securely fastened to the body.
- Ladders One twenty four (24) foot extension ladder.
- One twelve (12) foot roof ladder with folding rungs.
- Pike Poles Two (2) eight (8) foot.
- Roof Cutter One (1) eight (8) foot.

Lanterns	Two (2) Fire Dept. Standard.
Crow Bar	One (1) mounted on rear step.
Door Openers	One (1) "Detroit" door opener.
Axes	Two (2) Fire Dept. Standard.
Speedometer	One (1) equipped with maximum registering hands and reset lock.
Horns.	One (1) Sirens & R electrically operated. One (1) Bulb Horn.
Bell	One (1) 10# Jangle Bell.
Lights	One (1) Search Light. Two (2) head lights. Two (2) side lights. One (1) Tail light. One (1) extension light, all lights to be electric.

For the sum of \$5275.00, the same to be delivered at the engine house in Albany, Oregon within four months from the date of the signing of such contract.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:-

Section 1. The Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized and directed, with full power, to enter into a contract with Barrett Brothers to purchase one Combination Chemical and Hose Wagon and attachments, according to the above specifications for the price of \$5275.00, delivered at the engine house in Albany, Oregon, on or before four months from the signing of such contract.

Section 2. Upon the delivery of said Combination Chemical and Hose Wagon and attachments, the same shall be examined by the committee on fire and water and when found according to specifications, the said committee shall forthwith file a statement with the Recorder that the same has been delivered according to specifications and immediately after the filing of said statement, the Recorder may draw a warrant upon the general fund payable to said Barrett Brothers for the sum of \$5275.00.

Section 3. Whereas the fire apparatus of the City of Albany is insufficient for the necessities of the City and the public peace, health and safety is in danger and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
