An ordinance requiring the present holder of the franchise granted to the Willamette Valley and Coast Railroad Company by Ordinance No. 144 to construct a proper crossing on Lafayette Street where the railroad crosses Water Street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the Corvallis and Eastern Railroad Company, the present holder of the franchise granted to the Willamette Valley and Coast Railroad Company by Ordinance No. 144 be and they are hereby required to construct a proper crossing on Lafayette Street where the line of railroad crosses Water Street by removing all posts or piling from within said street and constructing a bridge or use on said street in such a manner as not in any manner to interfere with travel upon said Water Street at its intersection with Lafayette Street.

Section 2. That said work shall be done and performed and said Water Street made clear and free to travel within 90 days from the approval of this ordinance by the Mayor.
