

ORDINANCE NO. 458.

Ord 888

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany to enter into a contract with W. S. Weary for the building and construction of a lateral sewer to make Block 43, across H. M. Street and through Block 43 to connect with the lateral sewer now laid in the West portion of Block 43 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, according to the plans, prints and specifications filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 23rd day of July, 1913.

Whereas by resolution No. 450 of the City of Albany, Oregon passed by the council on the 23d day of July, 1913, it was ordered that a lateral sewer be constructed through Block 43, across H. M. Street and through Block 43 to connect with the lateral sewer now laid in the West portion of Block 43 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, a said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans and specifications and estimates of the city engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany; and,

Whereas it was provided by ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids to the owners of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and,

Whereas after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to said ordinance on the 10th day of September, 1913, W. S. Weary presented to the council of said city his bid for making said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and by said ordinance, by which bid said W. S. Weary proposed to furnish all materials and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the aforesaid improvement for the sum of \$450.00 or less;

Whereas W. S. Weary was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the sum of \$450.00 or less;

Therefore,

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany do accept the bid of W. S. Weary for said improvement to and the council hereby accepts and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are held to be authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said W. S. Weary for the making of said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer shall commence without

days after the signing of said contract and to prosecute with such vigor the breach and violation in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of November, 1913, and the City of Albany, N.Y., shall be deemed to suffer damages to the amount of \$5.00, and for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time.

Said contract also provides that the said W.S. Weare shall furnish, and the same shall pay in full to all persons supplying to the City of Albany, labor or material for the prosecution of the hereinabove described work and that the said W.S. Weare shall not permit any fine or costs to be filed or executed against the City of Albany, or on account of any material or labor furnished in the said work.

Such contract shall also contain a condition that no person shall be employed longer than eight hours in any one day or forty-eight hours in a week unless in case of emergency where other competent labor is available and that in such cases overtime shall be paid at double wages for over time.

Such contract shall also contain a condition that the contractor shall furnish at the option of the City of Albany, for any willful failure or negligence on the part of the said W.S. Weare to faithfully perform the contract according to its terms.

The said W.S. Weare shall furnish a penal bond in the sum of \$200, on which he shall give sufficient securities to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of said contract on the part of the said W.S. Weare and particularly against any claim or fine on labor, work or material on the part of any person claiming under said contract.
