

ORDINANCE NO. 610

Ord 690

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer through Block 3 in the Greater Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, into Baker Street to connect to the main sewer to be constructed on Baker Street, providing how the cost of said improvement shall be paid and the penalties for damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons causing the same if the work is not completed within the time as hereinabove set forth, of a good and sufficient bond for the payment, performance of the work and its execution and providing for the signing of the Recorder of the City of Albany; and for notice of filing the same in the office of the Recorder.

The 1st day of the City of Albany in the following year,

Section. That there shall be constructed a six inch vitrified terra cotta sewer through Block 3 in the Greater Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and into Baker Street to connect with the main sewer to be constructed on Baker Street.

Paid improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon and the plans and specifications of the City Engineer of said City, for the construction of said sewer will be filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 10th day of September, 1913.

The cost of said lateral sewer from the front line of said Block to the connection with the main sewer in Baker Street and to paid by the City of Albany out of the general fund of said City; the sum due in proportion of the cost of said improvement shall be paid for at the rate of one tenth and arising out of the assessment heretofore made as contained and directed by ordinance No. 689 passed by the council of the City of Albany on the 2nd day of September, 1913 as the rates and parts of lots in said Block 3 and especially and particularly where such lot is described by a parcel by the charter of the City of Albany.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 15th day of November, 1913.

All bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing said contract shall be execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with and sufficient

surchis to be approved by the assessors of the City of Albany in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars for the faithful performance of all the conditions of said contract.

Section 1. Any person or corporation entering into any contract with the city of Albany to make such improvements shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, and it shall be deemed to suffer damage on account thereof to the amount of five dollars per day for each calendar day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount is to paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvements is extended by the council.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give public notice of this ordinance in said improvements by publishing notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a newspaper published in said city of Albany fully describing in said article the time and manner of doing the work of said improvements.
