

Ord. 715

An ordinance authorizing the purchase of a team of gray percheron horses - i.e. also old name J. C. Hartman and paying for the payment for.

Whereas the City of Albany is without a team of horses, and Whereas J. C. Hartman has offered to sell to the City of Albany a team of gray percheron horses five years old for the sum of \$350.00; and

Whereas the City of Albany has sold the team of horses it did own for the sum of \$200.00, which sum of \$200.00 is now placed in the chest and of the City of Albany;

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain & Enact

Section 1. That the City of Albany hereby agrees to purchase of J. C. Hartman for the sum of \$350.00, one team of gray percheron five year old horses for the sum of \$350.00, and in payment therefor one check drawn on the street fund for the sum of \$350.00 payable to the said J. C. Hartman and deliverable by the superintendent of Streets to the said J. C. Hartman and the said team of horses to be purchased shall be delivered to the City of Albany.
