



Revised Albany Code

...improvement, and especially and particularly beneficial interests, as provided by the charter of said city.

...said improvement to said portion of said Ninth Street shall be completed by the 1st day of September, 1914.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said street deemed unacceptable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation who or whom any contract may be made with the City of Albany to make said improvement shall be bound to execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety in the sum of five thousand dollars in the full performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvement shall fail to complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said City shall be deemed to receive damages on account thereof to the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement to said portion of Ninth Street, as provided in the ordinance heretofore passed in this behalf, and to cause the same to be published in the City of Albany, fully describing the said work, the time and manner of doing the work, and the improvement of said street.
