An ordinance to repeal Section 2 of Ordinance No. 436 of the City of Albany, entitled "An ordinance prohibiting the sale of intoxicating liquors in the City of Albany, and regulating liquor stores, billiard and pool parlors, soft drink parlors and places, restaurants, and other places of business and declaring all places in the City of Albany where intoxicating liquors are sold, bartered or given away in violation of law or where persons are permitted to resort for the purpose of drinking intoxicating liquors, and the intoxicating liquors, bottles, glasses and other property kept in and about such premises such a place to be common nuisances and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith", passed the council January 26, 1908, approved January 30, 1908.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 436 entitled, "An ordinance prohibiting the sale of intoxicating liquors in the City of Albany and regulating liquor stores, billiard and pool parlors, soft drink parlors and places, restaurants, and other places of business and declaring all places in the City of Albany where intoxicating liquors are sold, bartered or given away in violation of law or where persons are permitted to resort for the purpose of drinking intoxicating liquors, and the intoxicating liquors, bottles, glasses, kegs and other property kept in and about such premises such a place to be common nuisances and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith" passed the council January 26, 1908, approved January 30, 1908, be and the same be repealed.
