

Having Albany, Oregon

Ord No
751

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon to enter into a contract with Asphalt & Machinery Company for the improvements of the alley running through the center of Block Five (5) in the City of Albany, Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Whereas by ordinance No. 745 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the alley running through the center of Block Five (5) in the City of Albany, Oregon, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said alley to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the alley full width with asphaltic concrete or similar pavement.
- Third: By constructing inlets.
- Fourth: By laying sewer pipe.
- Fifth: By topping sewer.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

Whereas it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of the said improvements in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

Whereas after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit on the 7th day of September, 1900 Asphalt & Machinery Company, a corporation, presented to the council of the City of Albany its bid for making said improvements with asphaltic concrete pavement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the council, by which said bid Asphalt & Machinery Company proposed to furnish all material and implements on site and the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with asphaltic concrete pavement in the following manner, to-wit:

Excavation, per cubic yard	\$.60
Fill, per cubic yard	.10
Pavement, per square yard	1.25
Pavement, curb, per linear foot	.30
Topping sewer, each	7.00

Inlets, style A, each	10.00
6 inch vitrified sewer pipe, per lineal foot	.50
Wood heave, per lineal foot	.10
Manholes, each	3.00

And Whereas, said Asphalt Machinery Company were the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor

Section 1. That the bid of Asphalt Machinery Company for said improvement of said described alley with asphaltic concrete pavement and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Asphalt Machinery Company for the making of said improvement with asphaltic concrete pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and to be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of November, 1904, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$5.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time and that the Asphalt Machinery Company furnish a bond in the sum of two hundred dollars to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having as surety one surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of Asphalt Machinery Company and further indemnifying the City of Albany against and saving it or them from labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
