An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon to enter into a contract with Asphalt Machinery Company for the improvement of Ferry Street from the north line of Ninth Street to the north line of Twelfth Street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Whereas by ordinance No 7018 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: Ferry Street from the north line of Ninth Street to the north line of Twelfth Street be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with Asphaltic Concrete Pavement.
- Third: By laying and constructing Asphaltic Concrete Kerbs.
- Fourth: By constructing catch Basins.
- Fifth: By constructing gulleys.
- Sixth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany, and

Whereas it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of the said improvement in the addresses provided by law and by said ordinance; and

Whereas after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the ordinance aforesaid, to-wit on the 7th day of October, 1914 Asphalt Machinery Company, a corporation, presented to the Council of the City of Albany its bid for making said improvement with asphaltic concrete pavement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the ordinance aforesaid and Asphalt Machinery Company proposed to furnish all material and implements and labor for the same necessary to make the above described improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Pavement for the following reasons, to-wit:

Excavations, per cubic yard	\$ .65
Fill, per cubic yard	.10
Cement, per square yard	1.00
Cement headers, per linear foot	.35
Tapping Sewers, each	7.00
Manholes, stone "4" each	10.00
6 inch vitrified sewer pipe, per linear foot	1.00
Wood headers, per linear foot	.25
Monuments, each	25.00

And Whereas said Asphalt Machinery Company was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

Section 1. That the bid of Asphalt Machinery Company for said improvement of said described portion of Turner Street with Asphaltic Concrete Pavements be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Asphalt Machinery Company for the making of said improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinafter mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that the work of such improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of November, 1914, and the City of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damage to the extent of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the Asphalt Machinery Company furnish a bond in the sum of twenty five hundred dollars, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having no sureties save and these and authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditional upon the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of Asphalt Machinery Company and further indemnifying the City of Albany against and liable for all claims for damages, work or materials on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
