

ORDINANCE NO. 157.

Rawlins, Albany, Oregon

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer beginning at the sewer on the west side of Block No. 2 in Hacklemans Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, running thence westwardly across La Fayette Street and thence obliquely along the center of Block 17 in Hacklemans Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid and the penalties or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same be not completed within the time agreed upon and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of Albany of proper notice for bids for the completion of said improvement.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sewer beginning at the sewer on the west side of Block No. 2 in Hacklemans Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, running thence westwardly across La Fayette Street and thence obliquely along the center of Block 17 in Hacklemans Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon and plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said city for the construction of said sewer filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 9th day of September, 1914.

The cost of said lateral sewer across La Fayette Street shall be paid by the City of Albany out of the general fund of said city; the unclaimed portion of the cost of said improvement shall be paid out of the moneys collected and arising out of the assessments to be made, ascertained and declared by ordinance on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said improvement not to make and specially and particularly restricted hereby as provided by the Charter of said city.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of December, 1914.

All bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the council of the said village may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation which will make and contract may be entered into by the City for the making of said improvement shall before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing of such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city, a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in the sum of \$10,

the faithful performance of said contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damage on account thereof to the amount of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 3. The recorder of said city is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Democrat, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
