

Rawlings, Albany, Oregon

an ordinance concerning a surplus as a result of street paving by the Asphalt Machinery Company on the alley running through the center of Block Five (5) in the City of Albany, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said alley through Block Five heretofore assessed and entered of record in the docket of city taxes in the City of Albany, Oregon, on making such improvement, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of .0162 per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and the Asphalt Machinery Company for the improvement of the alley through the center of Block Five in the City of Albany and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said alley through Block Five heretofore assessed for making such improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Docket of Taxes in the surplus column thereof, a credit of .0162 percent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said alley through Block Five, said surplus to be in favor of the following persons, owners or reputed owners of such various parcels of real estate and in sums of \$1.00, to-wit:
