

Ordinance, to ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewer between Front and Water Streets, and running westerly across Oak Street, through the center of Block 2, across Sherman Street, through the center of Block 2, to within 40 feet of the east line of Main Street, all in the same Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement that is assessed upon each lot or lot thereof adjacent to said improvement, to direct the Recorder of the City of Albany to enter assessments of such assessments in the books of Citations as provided in the charter of said city.

Whereas, the City Engineer in pursuance of the directions of the Council of the City of Albany made plans, specifications and estimates for the construction of a lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewer between Front and Water Streets and running westerly across Oak Street, through the center of Block 2, across Sherman Street, through the center of Block 2, to within 40 feet of the east line of Main Street, all in the same Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 8th day of April, 1914, and

Whereas, the Council on the 22nd day of December, 1914, by Resolution 20. 44, duly adopted said Council, determined and resolved that it deem it expedient and that said Council proposed to construct said lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewer between Front and Water Streets, and running westerly across Oak Street, through the center of Block 2, across Sherman Street, through the center of Block 2, to within 40 feet of the east line of Main Street, all in the same Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner provided in said Resolution 20. 44, and

Whereas, in and by said Resolution 20. 44, adopted as above said by the Council, the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed sewer improvement as provided by the Charter of the City of Albany, and

Whereas, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said city of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement in the manner provided by the Charter of said city, and

Whereas, the said Council on and by said Resolution 20. 44 as mentioned and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement to be paid by the owner of each property adjacent to said improvement as mentioned in said Resolution 20. 44, the sum of \$2500.00, and the total probable cost of making said improve-

merit to be \$470.25.

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sewer shall be laid beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewer, between Front and Water Streets, and running westerly across Oak Street, through the center of Block 2, across Sherman Street, through the center of Block 2, to within 40 feet of the east line of Main Street, all in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, in accordance with said plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 8th day of April, 1904.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution of 1904 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$470.25, and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the property adjacent and especially an especially benefited thereby is the sum of \$386.75.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution of 1904 is hereby ascertained and determined to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots or parts thereof, as follows:
