



Sealing: Albany, Oregon

beginning at a point to the corner of said Lot 11 in said Block 11 and running southerly and easterly along the corner line of said Block 11 a distance of 535 feet to a point B near the north side of Hamilton Road; also beginning at a point where the above named lateral sewer intersects the corner of Lot 2, 11, 31 and 32 in said Block 11 and running a distance westerly between Lots 31 and 32 across a fence street and along the line between Lots 31 and 32 a distance of 100 feet to a point C; also beginning at the northeast corner of said Lot 49; thence northerly along the boundary line between said Lot 49 and the Second Addition a distance of 330 feet to a point D; thence southerly between the Second Addition and the Second Addition a distance of 100 feet to a point E; also beginning at the northeast corner of said Lot 12 and running southerly along the boundary line between said Lot 12 and said Property's Second Addition a distance of 100 feet to a point F; also beginning at a point near the northern boundary line of Hamilton Road, and in the City of Albany, Oregon, and being a total distance of 1,984 feet.

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinance of the City of Albany, Oregon, and plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said city for the construction of said lateral sewer as shown in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 13th day of July, 1914.

The cost of said lateral sewer shall be paid out of the same collected on the basis of the assessments to be made, a lien shall be declared by ordinance on the lots and part of lots adjacent to said improvement - to be made and levied by and payable by the lot owner thereon as provided by the charter of said City.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of August, 1915.

and his for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

And no person or corporation with whom any contract shall be entered into by the city for the making of said improvement shall be liable for any damages or expenses and at the time of signing these terms shall be held to be a sufficient bond with good and sufficient sureties to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in the sum of \$850.00 for the faithful performance of said contract.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time designated and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to have the same and account

thereof to the amount of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid to such contractor doing the work at the expiration thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 1. The Recorder of said city is hereby directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement by publishing such notice two days in the Albany Democrat Herald, a newspaper or is published in the said City of Albany, setting described in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
