

The Ordinance to establish and determine the probable cost of constructing a water power plant to furnish electrical light for Corvallis, etc., go'. The letter, signed by the trustees of said City, the Corporation, written on the 2d day of October, 1895, and approved by the Mayor on the 11th day of October, 1895, beginning at "the main little inlet creek" between Water and Main Street in the City of Corvallis, and running up the creek in a northerly direction, and through a little cleft of rock, and thence 60 feet to the center of the 8 ft. thick rock, and thence 60 feet to the City of Corvallis, Oregon, and so to within 100 feet of the first line of measurement from the City of Corvallis, Oregon, & distant 1000 feet above the same, determining and to clear the property, including all land, soil & grass, cost of surveying, improvement that is assessed upon same, lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said improvement; and to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Booklet of Assessments as provided by the Charter of said City.

Whereas, the City Engineer in pursuance of the directions of  
the Council of the City of Albany made plans, specifications and estimates  
for the construction of the above described lateral sewer, and filed said  
plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder of the City  
of Albany on the 31st day of April, 1914; and

Whereas the said Council on the 1st day of October, 1913, by Resolution No. 14, which acted by said Council, was referred to the Board of Education, it is ordered by said Council, that it deem it expedient and that said Board of Education be directed to construct the above described lateral, even; and

Whereas, in and by said Resolution No. 11, adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed amendment as provided by the Constitution of California; and

Whereas, it is the desire of our  
and direction of the Council of the said City or Corporation in  
right of which it is provided by an Ordinance in the manner provided by  
order of said Council.

At present, the bill is in a state of great suspense, and it is now in the hands of the Committee on Finance, who have been directed to report a bill to appropriate \$100,000 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the bill.

Therefore

Section 1. That a right in a vitrified terra cotta drainage culvert be given at the mouth of Oak Street, truck road, midway between Water and First Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westerly across said street, a distance of 26 feet, in Block 8, Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, to within eight feet of the east line of Sherman Street, the right of way being a distance of 27 1/2 feet, in accordance with said plan, and a specification of said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the City of Albany on the 8th day of April, A.D.

Section 2. That the cost of making said improvement in the manner herein before determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 14 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$119.19, and the pro rata rate of said improvement to be paid by the persons adjacent and especially who particularly benefit thereby is the sum of \$154.65.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said pro rata cost of said improvement is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 14 is hereby ascertained and determined to be the sum set out and fixed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots opposite thereto, as follows, to-wit:

Assessed at \$15.56
