

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with Asphalt Machinery Company, a corporation, for the improvement of Baker Street, from the south line of First Street to the north line of Third Street.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Whereas by Ordinance No. 8133, the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: Baker Street, from the south line of First Street to the north line of Third Street be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

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| First: | By grading said street to the proper sub-grade. |
| Second: | By paving the roadway of said street full width with asphaltic intersections with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation. |
| Third: | By constructing catch basins. |
| Fourth: | By constructing inlets. |
| Fifth: | By laying vitrified sewer pipe. |
| Sixth: | By laying sub-drain tile. |

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

Whereas it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids given and given before the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the ordinance was so made to-wit on the 20th day of June, 1915, Asphalt Machinery Company, a corporation, presented to the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, for an order said improvement with asphaltic concrete pavement, which bid was made in due form and in conformance with all the conditions imposed by law and the ordinance, and said bid said Asphalt Machinery Company agreed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with asphaltic concrete pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:

Rawlings: Albany, Oregon

Excavation per cubic yard,	\$0.75
Fill or embankment, per cubic yard,	\$0.30
Asphaltic concrete pavements, including the surface finishing course and the foundation complete, per square yard.	\$1.15
Set iron sewer pipe, per linear foot,	\$0.55
Inlets, Style "C", each,	\$17.00
Inlets, Style "B", each,	\$7.00
Gutter headers, per linear foot,	\$0.35
Tapping lateral or main sewer, each,	\$7.00
Ripping catch basins, each,	\$2.00
Digging trenches and laying French drain tile, comp. st., per linear foot,	\$0.10

And Whereas, said Asphalt Machinery Company was the lowest and best bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor:

Section 1. That the bid of Asphalt Machinery Company, a corporation, for said improvement of said described portion of Foster Street be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Asphalt Machinery Company, a corporation, for the making of said improvements with asphaltic concrete pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bidder's above mentioned bid.

Said contract shall provide that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of October, 1915; and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be liable to suffer damages to the amount of \$25,000, or less or more and every day the work is delayed said sum will increase, and that the Asphalt Machinery Company shall furnish a bond in the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned on the faithful performance of the said contractor the part of said Asphalt Machinery Company and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien or labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
