

His Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract with Jacobson Bado & Co. a corporation, for the building and construction of a main sewer beginning at a point on Cooper's River and running from thence along a feasible route to a point near the north end of Stage Street and thence south of a line said Office Street and Takeria Street to a point at or near the north end of said Office Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, according to the annexed plans, profiles and specifications filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 2nd day of June, 1915.

Whereas, the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany to advertise for bids for the construction of the above mentioned work, said bids to specify the price for which the work would be done for cash and also for city bonds, with an agreement on the part of the bidder that if the bid to accept bonds for the work was accepted the bidder would bid for and accept bonds to the amount of said contract at par and accrued interest; and

Whereas, the said Recorder did advertise for bids for the construction of said sewer in the manner provided by the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany; and

Whereas, on the 2nd day of June, 1915 Jacobson Bado & Co. a corporation presented to the Council of the City of Albany its bid for the building and construction of said sewer with vitrified sewer pipe, which said bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid said Jacobson Bado & Co. a corporation proposed to furnish all materials and implements and perform the labor necessary to build and construct said sewer with vitrified sewer pipe to be paid for by the said Jacobson Bado & Co. a corporation including for and to be allowed at par and accrued interest in the amount provided by the Charter of the City of Albany for the building of said sewer for the following manual prices, to-wit:

Laying 24 inch vitrified sewer pipe, complete, including excavation, without classification, and right, per lineal foot, \$2.25

Laying 20 inch vitrified sewer pipe, complete, including excavation, without classification, and right, per lineal foot, \$2.00

Laying vitrified "Y" branches, complete,
including excavation, without classification,
and refills, each, \$5.25

Constructing man holes, each, \$42.00

Constructing main force concrete Bulkhead,
including all work pertaining to same, per
cubic yard of concrete, \$ 12.50

and

Whereas, the City of Albany has not the cash to pay for
the building and construction of said sewer, and

Whereas, the bid of the said Jacobson Bask Co., was the
lowest and best bid for the building and construction of said sewer,
the same to be paid for by bidding for and accepting at par and accrued
interest the above mentioned work,

Therefore,

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That the bid of the said Jacobson Bask Co., a
corporation for the building and construction of said sewer begin-
ning at a point on Salmon River, and running from thence
along a feasible route to a point near the north end of Cottage Street
and thence eastward along Cottage Street and Takana Street to a point
at or near the north line of Klamath Street, in the City of Albany,
Oregon, according to the annexed plans, profiles and specifications,
filed in the office of the Recorder on the 3rd day of June, 1915, and the
same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are
hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said
Jacobson Bask Co., corporation for the building and construction
of said sewer with vitrified sewer pipe, on behalf of the City of Albany,
Oregon, in accordance with the annexed plans, profiles and specifica-
tions and upon the terms mentioned in said bid.

Said contract shall provide that the work on said
sewer shall commence within ten days after the signing of
said contract and to be prosecuted with such vigor that all the
work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on
or before the 20th day of August, 1915, and the City of Albany shall be
deemed to have acquiesced in the amount of \$200,000 per year.

and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and the said Jacobsen Babel Co., a corporation shall at the time of signing said contract, furnish a bond to the City of Albany in the sum of Three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of said Jacobsen Babel Co., a corporation and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claims or suits for loss, work or materials on the part of any person arising out of said contract.

Said contract shall also provide that the City of Albany shall without delay advertise the \$8,000.00 bonds authorized for the construction of said sewer and the said Jacobsen Babel Co., a corporation shall agree in said contract to bid for at par and accrued interest such bonds in an amount equal to the full contract price for the building and construction of said sewer and to accept said bonds in payment for the building and construction of said sewer.
