ORDINANCE NO. 355

AN ORDINANCE OUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORLGON TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH J. W. THAVIS FOR THE ILLTROVECENT OF WASHINGTON STREET FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF MINTH STREET TO THE HORTH TURB LINE OF THIRTEENTH STREET.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS by ordinance no. 950 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: Washington Street from the South line of Minth Street to the North curb line of Thirteenth Street, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
Escond. By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with asphalt concrete pavement of an as-

phaltic concrete foundation.
By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete headings. Third.

By constructing catch basins. By constructing inlets. Bylaying vitrified newer pipe. Fourth.

Fifth.

said improvement to be made in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the kecorder of the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bide for the making of said inprovement in the manner provided by law and by said Ordinance; and

WHEKEAS after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the kecorder of the City of Albany according to law and the Ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: on the 22nd day of March 1916, J. W. Travis presented to the Council of the City of A lbany, his bid for making said improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Pavement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the con ditions imposed by law and the Council by which said bid J. W. Travis proposed to furnish all the material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above desorised improvement with asphaltic concrete pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:

> Excavation, per cubic yard---- .65 Fill or embankment, per cubic yard------ .20 Amphaltic Concrete Surface, including the surface finishing course and the foundation complete, per square yard -- ----Six inch sewer pipe, per lineal foot ----- .50 Inlets, style "C", each---------\$17.00 Paving headers, per lineal foot----- .30 Monuments, each -----\$ 3.99

Tapping lateral and main sewer----- 7.00 AND WHELEAS, said J. W. Travis was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and hest bid therefore;

Section 1. That the bid of J. W. Travis for said improvement of said described portion of Washington Street with Apphaltic Concrete Payenent be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder

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of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing, with said J. W. Travis for the making of said improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon upon the terms mentioned in said tid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to virovide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of Aug. 1916, unless further time be extended by the Council of said City, and the City of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the said work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said J. W. Travis furnish a bond in the sum of \$3750.00 to be approved by the Mayor or the City of Albany, Oregon having as surety some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of J. W. Travis, and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
