

ORDINANCE NO. 356

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$540.00 TO COMPENSATE J. S. VANWINKLE FOR AUDITING THE BOOKS, ACCOUNTS, AND RECORDS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

WHEREAS the council of the City of Albany, Oregon did by Resolution No. 34 passed on the 13th day of January 1916, authorize and direct the Committee on Accounts and Current Expenses of said Council to employ a competent accountant to audit the books, accounts and records of said City, and

WHEREAS the said committee did thereafter employ J. S. VanWinkle to audit said books, accounts and records, and who did audit said books, accounts and records and render a report of his findings thereon, which said report is now on file in the office of the recorder of said City, THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the sum of \$540.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund of the Treasury of the City of Albany, Oregon, not otherwise appropriated for the payment of the claim of J. S. VanWinkle for auditing the books, accounts and records of said City.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the City Treasurer payable to the said J. S. VanWinkle for the amount hereby appropriated.
