AN OIDINATE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORD THE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO THEM INTO A CONTRACT WITH W.S. WEAVER FOR THE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION OF A LATERAL SEWTH BEGINNING ATTHE MAIN HOLE IN THE OAK STREET TRUNK SEWER BETWEEN FIRST AND SECOND STREETS AND AUMNING THEM ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OR SOON, WITH WITHOUT AND AND SPECIFICATIONS TIED IN THE OFFICE OF THE AUTOMOBIL OF THE CITY OF AL-BANY, ON THE 28TH DAY OF JUNE 1916.

WHENTAS, by Resolution to. 43 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 28th day of June 1916, it was ordered that a lateral sower be constructed be ginning at the manhole in the Oak Street Trunk Sewer between First and Second Etreets and running thence Eastward through Block 16 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon a distance of 282 feet, said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer, then on file with the Recorder of said City, and

WHTH TAS it was provided by ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for hils for the saking of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance, and

Weaver presented to the Council of said City his bid for the making of said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in comformity with all the condiditons imposed by law and by said ordinance, by which his are said W.S. Weaver shall not permit any lien or claim to be filed or prosecuted against the City of Albany, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of such contract on the part of said W.S. Weaver and particularly against any claim or lieu for labor, work,or material on the part of any person arising out of said contract.
