AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A SURPLUS ON ACCOUNT OF THE IMPROVEDENT OF FIRST STRIPT BY J. W.

TRAVIS FROM THE EAST LINE OF MAIN STRIPT TO THE WEST CURE LINE OF SHEARS STRIPT IN THE CITY OF ALBAMY, OR SON, AND DIRECTING THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY TO PLACE TO THE CHEDIT OF THE STYTKAL OWNERS OF THE VARIOUS PARCELS OF STAL PSTATE ADJACENT TO SAIL IMPROVED THE REPORCE ASSESSED AND ENTERED OF RECORD IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LITTS IN THE CITY OF ALPAMY, OREGON, FOR MAKING SUCH MISTON THERE, THERE PROPORTIONATE SHARF OF SUCH SURPLUS.

THE PFOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY LO CHDAIR AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That a surplus of I4.948 per cent is hereby ascontained and deplaced to exist upon the completion of the contract antered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and J. W. Travis
for the improvement of First Street from the East line of Main Street
to the West ourb line of Sherman Street in the City of Albany, Oregon,
and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement heretofore assessed for making such
improvement.

Section 2. The hecorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Docket of City Liens in the surplus column thereof a credit of I4.948 per cent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of improving said street, said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such parcels of real estate and in sums as follows, to-wit;
