ORDINANCE NO. 885.

AN ORDINARCE authorizing the issuance and sale of improvement bonds of the City of Albany, oregon for the improvement of First Street from the East line of Main sStreet to the West curb line of Sherman Street in said City, and Washington Street from the Ecuth line of Ninth Street to the North curb line of Thirteenth Street in said City, and on account of the construction of ten lateral sewers tributary to the Cottage Street trunk Sewer in said City, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 3245 and 3253, both inclusive, of Lord's Oregon Laws.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Albany, proceeded to improve First Street from the East line of "ain Street to the West curb line of Sherman Street by Ordinance No. 852 passed on "he 22nd day of March 1916, and approved by the Mayor March 22nd, 1916 in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor duly and regularly adopted, and did by said Ordinance levy and assessment against and upon the several lots or parts thereof, pieces or garcels of land affected by said improvement of said street, and by Ordinance No 879 passed on the 13th day of September 1916 and approved on the 16th day of September 1916 did declare a surplus on account of said improvement of said First Street, and said surplus has been duly placed to the credit of the reveral owners of the property assessed for such improvement, and the said assessment and surplus have been entered upon the Docket of City Liens as provided in said Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, Ore on proceeded to improve Washington Street from the South line of Hinth Street to the North curb line of Thirteenth Street, by Ordinance No 583 passed on the 22nd day of March 1916, and approved by the Mayor on the 22nd day of March 1916, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor duly and regularly adopted, and did by said Ordinance levy an assessment against and upon the several lots or parts thereof, pieces and parcels of land affected by said improvement of said street, and by Ordinance No 660 passed on the 13th day of September 1916 and approved on the 16th day of September 1916 and approved on the 16th day of September 1916 did declare a surplus on account of said improvement of said Washington Street, and said surplus has been duly placed to the credit of the several owners of the property assessed for said improvement, and the said assessment and surplus have been entered upon the Docket of City Liens as provided in said Ordinances; and

WHENEAS, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon proceeded to construct ten lateral sewers tributary to the Cottage Street Trunk Sewer in

said City, by Ordinance No. 844 passed on the 8th day of December 1915, and approved by the Mayor on the 8th day of December 1915 in accordance with the planes and apec ifications therefor duly and regularly adapted, and did by said Ordinance levy an assessment against and upon the several loss or parts thereof, pieces or parcels of land affected by the construction of said sewers, and by Ordinance No. 865 passed on the 28th day of June 1916 did declare a surplus on account of the construction of said sewers, and said surplus has been duly placed to the credit of the several owners of the property assessed for said improvement, and the said assessment and surplus have been duly entered upon the Docket of City Liens as provided in said Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, after due service of notice of such assessments and of the entry of the same in the Docket of City Liens there were filed with the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, written applications to pay said assessments in installments, and said applicants and property owners did thereby waive all irregularities or defects, jurisdictional or otherwise in the proceedings to improve the streets and to construct the sewers aforesaid for which said assessments were levied and in the apportionment of the cost thereof; and

WHEREAS, said applicants and properly owners agreed to pay said assessments in ten annual installments, with interest at the rate on all of said assessments which have not be nearly as that expressed in the bonds issued to pay for such improvements, and in all respects complied with the requirements of Chapter V, Title XXVI of Lord's Oregon Laws; and

WHEREAS, the applications as above are separate and are now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the same have been entered in the Bond Lien Docket; and

Whitehall, the total amount of the unpaid assessments for said street improvements and construction of said lateral sewers for which applications to pay under the provisions of the Act hereinabove referred to have been filed as shown by the Bond Lien Docket is the sum of \$9,352.51.

NOW THERRFORE

THE PROPIN OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Bection I. That the City of Albany, Oregon shall issue its bonds in all equal to the amount of \$9,352.51 it being the total amount of the unpaid assessments for the improvement of First Street from the East line of Main Street to the West ourb line of Sherman Street in said City, and Weshington Street from the South line of Minth Street to the North ourb line of Thirtcenth Street in said City, and on account of the construction of ten lateral sewers tributary to the Cottage Street Trunk Sewer in said City, and for which applications to pay under the provisions

Rend Lien Docket of the City of Albany, which said bonds shall be numbered from I to I9, both inclusive, and shall be in denominations of \$500,00 each, except bond No. 19 which shall be for the sum of \$352.51.

Section 2. That said bonds shall be dated the first day of April 1917 and shall by the terms thereof mature in ten years from the date thereof, and shall be payable in gold coin of the United State of America and bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, interest payable semi-annually; raid interest to be evidenced by coupons attached to said bonds which must have a number printed or inscribed thereon corresponding to that of the bond; both principal and interest to be payable at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Oregon in the City of New York.

Section 3. That the right to take up and cancel such bond or bonds, upon payment of the face value thereof, with accrued interest to the date of the payment at any semi-annual coupon period at or after one year from the date of such bond or bonds, is hereby reserved, said redemption of bonds if so made to be in accordance with the provisions of the law herein cited.

Section4. That such bonds before the issuance thereof shall be signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, and authentionted by the seal of said City; the coupons, however may have printed thereon a facsimile signature of the Mayor and Recorder, and shall be registered consecutively by number and denomination of each in a book kept by the Recorder to be known and designated as the "Improvement Bond Register".

Section5. That each of said bonds shall have distinctly and plainly inscribed or printed on the face thereof the registered number, and the words "Improvement Bond", with the name of the City and the words "1917 Series A".

Bection 6. That said bonds shall be advertised fro sale for a period of ten days from the date of the first publication and sold for the highest price obtainable, but for not less than par and accrued interest; and that the proceeds thereof shall be paid by the purchaser to the treasurer of the City of Albany, and the per value thereof credited to the respective street improvement and sewer funds for which said bonds are issued, and the accrued interest and premium, if any, accruing from the sale of said bonds shall be credited to the general fund of the City. The Accorder of the City of Albany, is hereby authorized and directed to advertise said bonds for sale.

Section 7. That said bonds and coupons shall be substantially in the following form:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the City of Albany, County of Linn, State of Oregon, for value received, hereby agrees and promises to pay of the bearer the sum of ______ Dollars in Gold Coin of the United States of America on the presentation and surrender of this obligation on the _____ day of ____ in the year of OUR LOHD ONE THOUSAND HINE HUNDRED AND THENTY-SEVEN, without grace, with interest thereon from the date thereof until redeemable at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually in like Gold Coin on the first day of _____ and the first day of _____ and the first day of _____ in each year of the proper coupons hereto attached, principal and interest payable at the Fiscal Afency of the State of Oregon in the City of New York.

This bond is one of a series authorized by an act of the Ligislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, entitled, " An Act to provide for the issuance of bonds for the improvement of streets and the laying of sewers in incorporated cities, and for the payment of the cost of such improvements and laying of sewers by installments", filed in the office of the Secretary of State February 22, 1893, as amended by an Act entitled "An Act to amend sections I,2,3,4,5,,6 and 7 of an Act entitled, 'An Act to provide for the issuance of bonds for the improvement of streets and the laying of ewers in incorporated cities, and for the payment of the cost of such improvements and laying of sewers by installments', filed in the office of the Secretary of State February 22, 1893", approved February 25, 1901, and subsequent amendahory acts thereto passed by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, and is an obligation of the City of Albany, aforesaid and is not to be deemed or taken to be within or any part of the limitation by law as to the indebtedness of said City of Albany, and it is further certified that all requirements of law have been fully complied with by the proper officers in the issuing of this bond, and that the total amount of this issue does not exceed the limit prescribed by said Act.

This bond is reddemable at the option of the City of Albany, upon the payment of the face value thereof with accrued interest to the date of payment at any semi-annual coupon period at or after one year from the date hereof, as provided is said Act.
