

ORDINANCE NO. 936

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A BURROUGHS ADDING MACHINE FOR THE RECORDER'S OFFICE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO DRAW A WARRANT AGAINST THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY FOR SAID AMOUNT.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the General Funds of the City of Albany the sum of Two Hundred Twenty-five (\$225.00) Dollars for the purpose of purchasing a Burroughs Adding Machine for the Recorder's Office of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the General Funds of said city for said amount.
