ORDINANCE NO. 823

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND DEFINE THE FIRE
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND TO
REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN
CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The fire limits of the City of Albany shall be bounded by a line commencing where the center line of Water Street intersects the center line of Washington Street and running thence Southerly following the center line of Washington Street to a point equally distant from the center lines Second Street and Third Street, thence Easterly parallel with the center line of Second Street to the center of Ferry Street at a point equally distant from Second Street and Third Street, thence Southerly along the center of Ferry to the center line of Third Street, thence Easterly along the center line of Third Street to a point in the center of said Third Street 67 1/8 feet Westerly from the West line of Lyon Street; thence Southerly parallel with the West line of Lyon Street and 67 1/8 feet Westerly from said line to a point in the center of Ninth Street which is 67 1/8 feet West from the West line of said Lyon Street; thence Easterly along the center line of said Ninth Street to a point in the center of said Ninth Street 67 1/8 feet Easterly from the West line of said Lyon Street; thence Northerly parallel with the East line of Lyon Street and 67 1/8 feet therefore to the center of Second Street, thence Easterly following the center line of Second Street to its intersection with the center line of Baker Street, thence Northerly following the center line of Baker Street to a point equally distant from the center lines of First Street and Water Street, thence Westerly parallel with the center line of First Street to the center line of Lyon Street, thence Northerly following the center line of Lyon Street to the center line of Water Street, thence Westerly following the center line of Water Street to the place of beginning.

Section 2. Whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.


