

ORDINANCE NO. 929

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY OREGON, UPON THE ASSESSMENT MADE IN 1918, SAID TAX TO BE COLLECTED IN 1919.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. That a tax levy for the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the assessment made in 1918, for taxes to be collected in 1919, be and the same is hereby made as follows:

General running expenses - - - - -	\$26,700.00
Interest on bond indebtedness - - - - -	\$ 6,200.00
Sinking fund \$75,000 refunding bonds - - -	\$ 2,200.00
" " \$22,000 City Hall site bonds -	\$ 1,600.00
" " \$12,000 Sewer Bonds - - - - -	\$ 1,767.00
" " \$ 8,000 " " - - - - -	\$ 534.00
Library Fund - - - - -	\$ 2,300.00
Sinking fund for warrant indebtedness and interest on proposed bond issues	<u>\$ 8,592.00</u>
Total Tax levy	\$ 49,893.00

Said tax levy shall be levied upon the equal assessment valuation of all assessable property, both real and personal, in said City of Albany, as shown upon the assessment roll of Linn County, Oregon, which said assessment was made in the year 1918.

Section. 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately notify the County Clerk and County Assessor of Linn County, Oregon, of this levy as provided by law.
