AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY ORBOON, UPON THE ARRESSMENT MADE IN 1918, SAID TAX TO BE COLLECTED IN 1919.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. That a tax levy for the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the assessment made in 1918, for taxes to be collected in 1919, be and the same is here by made as follows:
