

ORDINANCE NO. 947.

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 861½, ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND CONTROL
OF A PUBLIC MARKET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES
FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME", PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND AP-
PROVED BY THE MAYOR OF THE 16th DAY OF JUNE, 1916.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 861½ of the City of Albany, Oregon,
entitled "An Ordinance to provide for the establishment and control of a public
market in the City of Albany, and to provide a penalty for the violation of the
same", passed by the council on the 16th day of June, 1916, and approved by the
Mayor on the 16th day of June, 1916, be and the same is hereby repealed.
