

ORDINANCE NO. 949

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCES: ORDINANCE NO. 566, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL FEBRUARY 28, 1912, AND APPROVED MARCH 5 1912. ORDINANCE NO. 910, PASSED SEPTEMBER 26, 1917, AND APPROVED SEPTEMBER 26, 1917. ORDINANCE NO. 924 PASSED BY THE COUNCIL JUNE 12, 1918, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR JUNE 12, 1918.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 566, entitled "An Ordinance regulating the use of motor vehicles in the City of Albany, Oregon, repealing all ordinances and parts or ordinances in conflict herewith and providing a penalty for violation hereof", passed February 28, 1912, and approved March 5, 1912, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 910, entitled "An Ordinance regulating street traffic in the City of Albany and providing a penalty for violation thereof", passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor September 26, 1917, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 924, entitled, "An ordinance to provide for the display of registration number plates and a penalty for violation hereof", passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor June 12, 1918, be and the same is hereby repealed.
