ORDINANCE NO. 958.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 136 ENTITLED:

"AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CITY ELECTIONS AND THE CITY ORGANIZATION AND MANUER
OF CONDUCTING ELECTIONS," PASSED BY THE COUNCIL MAY 12, 1885, AND APPROVED
BY THE MAYOR MAY 13, 1885, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 743.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBARY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 136 entitled: "An Ordinance relating to City elections and the City organization and manner of conducting elections," passed by the Council May 12, 1825, and approved by the Mayor May 13, 1885, as amended by Ordinance No. 743 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That for the purposes of municipal representation the City of Albany be and is hereby divided into three wards designated and bounded as follows:

Ward No. 1 is hereby declared to include all that part of said city lying west of the center line of Washington Street if projected to points of intersection with the northern and southern boundary lines of said city.

Ward No. 2 is hereby declared to include all that part of said city lying east of the east boundary line of Ward No. 1 and west of the center line of Railroad Street if projected to points of intersection with the northern and southern boundary lines of said city.

Ward No. 3 is hereby declared to include all that part of the city lying east of Ward No. 2.
