ORDINANCE NO. 967.

AN ORDINANCE TO ASCERTAIN, DETERVINE AND DECLARS A DEFICIT ON ACCOUNT OF CONSTRUCTING A LATERAL SEWER SEGIMATION AT A MAMMOLE IN THE RAILROAD STREET TRUMK SEVER, MIDWAY SETWEEN SECOND AND THIRD STREETS, AND KUMNING THENCE RACTERLY THROUGH THE CENTER OF BLOCKS 104 and 111, OF HACKLEVAN'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, GREGON, AND TO ASCERTAIN, REASERS, DETERMINE AND DECLARS THE PROPORTICUATE SHARE OF SUCH DEFICIT THAT IS RE-ASSESSED UTON EACH LOT OR A PART THEREOF, ADJACENT TO EATE SUCH DEFICIT TO LATERAL SEVER, AND TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO EMTER SUCH DEFICIT TO LEVIED IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIETS, AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY, AND TO CANCEL ASSESSMENTS HARTOFORE MADE AGAINST SAID PROPERTY IN BLOCK 112 OF HACKLEMAN'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, ON THE 24th DAY OF MARCH, 1920, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY PASSED ORDINANCE NO. 961, ASCESSING UPON THE LOTS OR PARTS THRIFOF, IN BLOCKS 104, 111 AND 112 OF MACKINIAN'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, CRECON, CERTAIN ALDUNTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A LATERAL SEVER THROUGH SAID BLOCKS OR SUCH PORTIONS OF THE THEM LATERAL SEVER AS SHOULD DEED REPLACEMENT.

WHEREAS THE SAID IMPROVEMENT HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND THE CONTRACTOR'S FINAL FIGURES HAVE REEN FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, AND THE CITY COUNCIL HAS SETTLED WITH THE CONTRACTOR FOR SAID IMPROVEMENTS, AND

WHEREAS IT IS FOUND BY THE COUNCIL THAT THE SUMS ASSESSED IN SAID ORDINANCE UPON THE SEPARATE LOTS OR PARTS THEREOF, IN BLOCKS 104 and 111 GF HACKLERAN'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, AS DESCRIBED IN SAID ORDINANCE NO. 961, AND EACH OF THEM IS INSUFFICIENT TO DEFRAY THE COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENT AND THAT THE TOTAL ASSESSED AS ASSESSED, ASCERTAINED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED BY THE SAID ORDINANCE NO. 961, IS INSUFFICIENT TO PAY THE COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENT BY THE SUM OF SEVENTY WINE DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (\$79.20) AND THAT IT IS EXCESSARY TO RE ASSESS THE SAID REAL PROPERTY, AND

THEREAS THE CONTRACTOR IN THE EXECUTION OF HIS SAID CONTRACT, AND THE CITY COUNCIL FOUND THAT IT WAS UNNECESSARY TO REPLACE THE LATERAL STWEE THEN EXISTING THROUGH BLOCK 112 OF HACKLEHAN'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, CREGON, AND THE LIEN CREATED BY ORDINANCE NO. 961 AGAINST THE PROPERTY IN SAID BLOCK 112 OF HACKLEHAN'S ADDITION SHOULD BE CANCELLED.

THEREFORE

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council hereby ascertains, determines and declares that there is a deficit in the assessment made in said Ordinance No. 961 as against the property in Blocks 104 and 111 of Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, in the sum of \$79.20, and that there be and is hereby re-assessed the same to be in excess of the original assessment against the several parcels of land whose owners or reputed owners, together with the description of the property assessed, is owned by each of them respectively with the amount of such deficit assessment charged to each of them respectively, is as follows:
