

ORDINANCE NO. 969.

AN ORDINANCE to ascertain, determine and declare a deficit on account of constructing a lateral sewer beginning at the end of a ten inch lateral sewer, connecting with the Baker Street trunk sewer, at the intersection of the West line of Baker Street and the center of the alley between Fourth and Fifth Streets and running thence Westerly through the center of said alley through Block 5 of the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, and Block 30 of the City of Albany, a distance of 668.5 feet to the East line of Ellsworth Street, and to ascertain, re-assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such deficit that is re-assessed upon each lot or a part thereof, adjacent to said lateral sewer, and to direct the Recorder of the City of Albany to enter such deficit so levied in the Docket of City Liens, as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of May, 1920, the Council of the City of Albany passed Ordinance No. _____, assessing upon the lots or parts thereof in Block 5 of the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany and Block 30 of the City of Albany, certain amounts for the construction of a lateral sewer through said blocks.

WHEREAS, the said improvement has been completed and the contractor's final figures have been filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, and the City Council has settled with the Contractor for said improvements, and

WHEREAS, it is found by the Council that the sums assessed in said ordinance upon the separate lots or parts thereof, in Block 5 of the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and Block 30 of the City of Albany, Oregon, as described in said Ordinance No. _____, and each of them is insufficient to defray the cost of said improvement and that the total assessment as assessed, ascertained, determined and declared by the said Ordinance No. _____ is insufficient to pay the cost of said improvement by the sum of One Hundred Sixty-four Dollars and Fifty-four Cents (\$164.54) and that it is necessary to re-assess the said real property.

T H E R E F O R E

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council hereby ascertains, determines, and declares that there is a deficit in the assessment made in said Ordinance No. _____ as against the property in Block 5 of the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and Block 30 of the City of Albany, Oregon, in the sum of \$164.54, and that there be and is hereby re-assessed the same to be in excess of the original assessment against the several parcels of land whose owners or reputed owners, together with the description of the property assessed, as owned by each of them respectively with the amount of such deficit assessment charged to each of them respectively, is as follows:

vided in the Charter of said City.
