

ORDINANCE No. 977

An ORDINANCE naming a street running from a point between Third and Fourth Streets on Main Street in an Easterly direction to Geary Street, said street being generally known as Santiam Road and defining the boundaries thereof.

Whereas, there is situated within the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon a public street, said street running from Main Street East to Geary Street and being generally known as Santiam Road; and

Whereas, the said City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon has exercised full, complete and absolute control over said street and the whole thereof since the date of the incorporation of the said city; and

Whereas, the said city of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, has maintained and exercised absolute control over the maintenance of said street and paid the cost thereof since the time heretofore mentioned; and

Whereas, on the 9th day of March, 1921, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer of said city to mark the boundaries of said street generally known as Santiam Road with proper and durable monuments, and further requiring from said Engineer a plat showing the location of said road and the boundaries thereof as marked; and

Whereas, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 7, did mark the said boundaries of said street generally known as Santiam Road with proper monuments and filed the same in the office of the City Recorder of Albany, Oregon on the 21st day of March, 1921, and a plat showing the location of said road and the boundaries thereof.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the public street running from a point between Third and Fourth Streets on Main Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, in an Easterly direction to Geary Street and generally known as Santiam Road ^{be} and the same is hereby described as follows:

Said road is 60 feet wide lying equally 30 feet either side and at right angles to the following described center line:

Except that the intersection of the North and South lines of said road with the East line of Main Street are 33.2 feet ^{13° 15' 15"} and 33.2 feet ^{13° 15' 15"} respectively, measured on and along the East line of Main Street from the hereinafter described center line. Also that the intersections on the center line of Geary Street with the North and South lines of the said road are 32.4 feet respectively, measured North and South on and along the center line of Geary Street from the following described center line:

Beginning at a point where the center line of the Santiam Road intersects the East line of Main Street, which point is distant 33 feet North and 4.8 feet West from the N.W. corner of the Jones Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, which corner is marked with an iron bar driven one foot below the surface of the ground, which bar is shown by the records in the office of the Recorder of Linn County, Oregon, to have been established in the year 1890; thence S. 72° 58' E. 973.4 feet intersecting the center line of Pine Street on the North; thence on same course 84.4 feet intersecting Pine Street on the South; thence on the same course 557.4 feet to the center line of Cleveland Street; thence on same course 13.8 feet to the center line of Denver Street on the South; thence on same course 103 feet; thence S. 67° 55' E. 167.3 feet to the center line of Denver Street on the North; thence on same course 240.4 feet to the center of Seventh Street running westerly; thence on same course 34.1 feet to a point 0 feet right and at right angles from the S.E. corner of Block 11 of Bryant's Addition to the City of Albany; thence S. 66° W. 45.5 feet to the center line of Geary Street.

Section 2. That the public street described in Section 1 of this Ordinance

hance be known as Santian Street.

Section 3. That the Recorder of the City of Albany file a copy of this Ordinance in the office of the County Recorder of Linn County, Oregon.


