

# ORDINANCE NO. 1001.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY OREGON TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH L.O. HERROLD FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE ALLEY BETWEEN THIRD STREET AND FOURTH STREET THROUGH BLOCK NO. 19 IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 997 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following Alley in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: The Alley between Third Street and Fourth Street in Block No. 19 be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said Alley to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said Alley full width with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation, or by paving said Alley with Portland cement concrete pavement, or by paving with Warrenite bitulithic wearing surface upon a bituminous concrete base at the option of the Council.
- Third: By laying six inch sewer pipe.
- Fourth: By constructing inlets.
- Fifth: By constructing wooden headers.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the Ordinance last aforesaid; and

WHEREAS, the Council in and by Resolution No. 22 did adopt and select Asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base as a most advantageous kind of pavement for making such improvement and to-wit: on the 18th day of July, 1921, L.O. Herrold presented to the Council of the City of Albany its bid for making said improvement with Asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base pavement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid L.O. Herrold proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with Asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:

AND WHEREAS, said L.O. Herrold was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

Section 1. That the bid of L.O. Herrold for said improvement be and the same

is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with L.O. Herrold for making said improvement with Asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon upon the terms in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 15th day of September, 1921 and the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$ 25.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond the specified time, and that L.O. Herrold furnish a bond in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1400.00) to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having as surety some surety Company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon or some person justifying in twice the amount of said bond, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of L.O. Herrold and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.


