ORDINANCE NO. 1046

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE Fixing the salary of the City Marshal of the City of Albany.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO GRDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Marshal of the City of Albany shall receive from and after the date of the passage and approval of this ordinance by the Mayor the sum of \$100.00 per month, the same being payment in full for all services rendered by said City Marshal as previded by the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.
