Section 8. That the owners of the foregoing described property. or their successors in interest who may hereafter desire to connect up for drainage purposes their property or any part thereof with the sewer described in Ordinance No. 964, of the City of Albeny, which make application to the Common Council of the City of Albany, and upon payment of the proportionate share of the cost of the construction of said sewer to the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, they may proceed to make said connection.

The proportionate share of the cost of any person Section 3. desiring to connect up with said sewer shall be determined and fixed by the Common Council of the City of Albany, and the finding of the Council thereon shall be final and conclusive.
