ORDINANCE NO. 1068

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE concerning the piling of cord wood and the storage of the same in the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to pile cord wood for storage, resale or the purpose of operating a wood yard within the fire limits of the City of Albany as now or as may hereafter be defined by the Common Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, by ordinance, provided, however, that this does not apply to wood for consumption in business houses, or residence houses, situated within said fire limits, and provided, further, that permits may be granted by the Fire and Water Committee of the Council upon application to pile wood within said limits when they deem it does not constitute a fire hazard.

Section II. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to deliver wood to any place or places within the City and to dispose of the same upon any street or public way, unless such wood is neatly piled and corded up.

Section III. Any person, persons, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, for each and every offense, be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) and in default of the payment of such fine be imprisoned in the City jail for a period of not less than two days nor more than ten days.
