

ORDINANCE NO. 1086

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE To ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined in Resolution No. 15, adopted by said Council on the 27th. day of June, 1923, to make on Eleventh Street from the West line of Ferry Street West to the East line of Calapocia Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said Eleventh Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Eleventh Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the charter of said City.

WHEREAS, On the 23rd. day of May, 1923, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Eleventh Street from the West line of Ferry Street West to the East line of Calapocia Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the following manner, to-wit:

1. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
2. By paving said street full width with asphaltic concrete on a crushed rock base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on a crushed gravel base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on an asphaltic base; or by paving with Portland cement paving.
3. By paving headers.
4. By constructing inlets.
5. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.
6. By taping sewers.

and for estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Eleventh Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 8" and adopted the 23rd. day of May, 1923, and

WHEREAS, The City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 8 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of Eleventh Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 8 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office in said City on the 27th. day of June, 1923, and

WHEREAS, The said Council on the 27th. day of June, 1923 by Resolution No. 15, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve Eleventh Street from the West line of Ferry Street West to the East line of Calapocia Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 15; and

WHEREAS, In and by said Resolution No. 15 adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Eleventh Street from the West line of Ferry Street West to the East line of Calapocia

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Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, as provided by the charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, The Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Eleventh Street in the manner provided by the charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, The said Council in and by said Resolution No. 15 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Eleventh Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Eleventh Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 15, to be the sum of Six Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-four and Seventy-four hundredths Dollars (\$6224.74).

T H E R E F O R E.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Eleventh Street from the West line of Ferry Street West to the East line of Calapooia Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

1. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
2. By paving said street full width with asphaltic concrete on a crushed rock base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on a crushed gravel base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on an asphaltic base; or by paving with Portland cement concrete paving.
3. By paving headers.
4. By constructing inlets.
5. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.
6. By taping sewers.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 15, and the plans and specifications for the specifications for said improvement filed by the City of Albany on the 27th. day of June, 1923.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Eleventh Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West line of Ferry Street West to the East line of Calapooia Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of the said City of Albany, Oregon, in and by said Resolution No. 15, by paving said street full width with asphaltic concrete on a crushed rock base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on a crushed gravel base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on an asphaltic base; or by paving with Portland cement concrete paving, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Eleventh Street is hereby declared to be the sum of Six Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-four and Seventy-four hundredths Dollars (\$6224.74).

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Eleventh Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Eleventh Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 15, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate

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description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows, to-wit:

DESCRIPTION OF EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF ADJACENT TO SAID IMPROVEMENT ON SAID ELEVENTH STREET.

Fieder, E.L.

Beginning at the S.E. corner of Block 90 in Monteith's Southern Addition to the City of Albany; thence N. on the E. line of said Block 55 feet, thence W. parallel with the S. line of said Block 95 feet; thence S. 55 feet; thence E. 95 feet; thence S. 55 feet; thence E. 95 feet, to beginning. 95 feet on Eleventh Streets, Assessed at \$551.63

Larson, O. H.

The E. 80 feet of the N.E. 1/4 of Block 101 in Monteith's Southern Addition to the City of Albany. 80 feet on Eleventh Street Assessed at \$464.53

Hood, Irvine L. & Josephine

The W. 54 feet of the N.E. 1/4 of Block 101 in Monteith's Southern Addition to the City of Albany. 54 feet on Eleventh Street Assessed at \$313.55

Emmons, Mary E.

The E. 1/2 of the N.W. 1/4 of Block 101 in Monteith's Southern Addition to the City of Albany. 67 feet on Eleventh Street Assessed at \$389.05

Shelvik, Paul

The W. 1/2 of the N.W. 1/4 of Block 101 in Monteith's Southern Addition to the City of Albany. 67 feet on Eleventh Street Assessed at \$389.05

Section 4. That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessment made and declared by this ordinance together with the names of the respective owners of such lot or part thereof hereinabove described in the Docket of City liens of the said City of Albany as provided in the charter of said City.
