ORDINANCE NO. 1088

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE To ascertein and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined in Resolution No. 13, adopted by said Council on the 23rd. day of May, 1923, to make on Broadelbin Street from the North line of First Street North to the South line of Water Street in the City of Albany, Oregon; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate stare of such probable cost of such improvement of said Broadalbin Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Broadalbin Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of auch assessment in the Docket of Wity Liens as provided by the charter of said SCI tv.

WHEREAS, On the 23rd. day of May, 1923, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Broadalbin Street from the North line of First Street North to the South line of Water Street in the wity of Albany, Oregon, in the following manner, to-wit:

- By grading said street to the proper subgrade. By peving said street full width with asphaltic concrete on a crushed rock base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on a crushed gravel base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on an asphaltic base; or by paving with Portland cement concrete paving. and for estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Broadalbin Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 7." and adopted on the 23rd. day of May, 1923, and

WREREAS. The City Engineer of seld city of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 7 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of Broadalbin Street in the marner specified in said Resolution No. 7 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office in said City on the 27th, day of June, 1923, and

WHEREAS, The said Council on the 27th. day of June, 1923, by Resolution Mo. 13, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council proposed to improve Broadalbin Street from the North line of First Street North to the South line of water Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 13; and

WHEREAS, In and by said Resolution No. 18, adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Broadalbin Street from the North line of First Street North to the South line of Water Street in the wity of albany, Oregon, as provided by the charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, The Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Broadalbin Street in the manner provided by the charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, The said Council in and by said Resolution No.13, ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Broadalbin Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Broadalbin Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 13, to be the sum of Twenty-pevon Hundred Sixty and Eighty-one hundredths Dollars (\$2760.81).

THEREFORE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLICITS:

Section 1. That Broadalbin Street from the North line of First Street North to the South line of Water Street in the City of Albany. Oregon, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- By grading sold street to the proper subgrade.
 By paving sold street full width with asphaltic concrete on a crushed rock base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete on a crushed gravel base; or by paving with esphaltic concrete on an asphaltic base; or by paving with Fortland cement concrete paving. By paving headers.

- constructing inlets laying vitrified sewer pipe.
- taping sewers.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 13 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 27th, day of June, 1923.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Broadalbin Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the North . line of First Street Borth to the South line of Water Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of the said City of Albany, Oregon, in and by said Resolution No. 13, by reving seld street, full width with asphaltic concrete on a crushed rock base; or by paving with asphaltic opnorate on a crushed gravel base; or by paving with asphaltic concrete en an asphaltic base; or by paving with Portland dement concrete paving, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Broadalbin Street is hereby declared to be the sum of Twenty-seven Eundred Sixty and Eighty-one Hundredths Dollars (\$2780.61).

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Broadalbin Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Broadslbin Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 13, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows, to-wit:
